The Need for Nighttime Chaperones

Your youth group is made up of active and excited youngsters in a new place with a myriad of things to see and do in a short period of time. They return to their rooms still "revved-up" from the day's activities and excited about tomorrow. It sometimes takes hours for the "adrenaline rush" to wear off. This can cause headaches and a loss of sleep for your adult leaders.

InDev's chaperones can help; we monitor the halls during the "secure doors period" to keep youth safely in their rooms and disturbances to a minimum. Using room rosters, the chaperones turn away any unwanted guests, address small student needs that may arise, and alert the appropriate leader of situations requiring attention.

Why Chaperones: Not Security Guards

Nighttime chaperones monitor room-door and hallway activities, keep track of youth group members that leave their room during monitored hours, turn away unwanted/unapproved guests, and ensure appropriate assistance is provided if needed.

Security Guards provide a similar but distinctly different service. Security guard protection services focus on thwarting hostile activities such as theft or attack where their primary function is to disrupt such acts and detain suspects. Security guards use police style approaches and tactics, and maintain high visibility as a deterrent to crime.

Chaperones provide discreet, low profile, "gatekeeper" monitoring of kids to ensure safe and restful sleep for both youth and leaders with minimal disruptions.
